

The fittings pack contains SMALL ITEMS which should be KEPT AWAY FROM YOUNG CHILDREN.





## Sandford assembly instructions


I. Remove all cushions and carefully turn over the upholstery. Unpack the leg assemblies (A) and place on a blanket or carpeted floor to prevent scratching. If assembling a medium or large motion lounger or large sofa unpack the centre leg (B) as well.




2. Unscrew the transit feet by turning anti-clockwise. Once removed these can be disposed of.




3. Using the allen key (C) undo and keep the 10 bolts (a) on the underside of the upholstery.




4. Take one leg assembly (A) and line up the bolts holes on the upholstery. Take 5 of the bolts (a) previously removed and and insert into each hole.




5. Tighten each bolt in a clockwise direction using the allen key provided (C).



6. Repeat steps 4 and 5 for the remaining leg assembly (A).




7. Medium and Large Motion Lounger and Large Sofas only: Take the centre leg (B) and line up with the bolt hole in the centre of the sofa. Hand tighten the centre leg by turning in a clockwise direction.




8. Carefully turn the upholstery back over and replace the cushions.

### Connecting the power - Motion Loungers Only

- I. All Sofa Sizes: It is best to position the sofa near the power source. Facing the back of the sofa find the 2 two pin connectors towards the outer edges, I on each side. Push the 2 pin connectors into each side of the splitter cable (G).
- 2. Push the 2 pin connector on the splitter cable into the power adaptor (F) and close the locking cover.
- 3. Finally insert the power cable (E) into the power adaptor.






#### How to operate

- I. Starting in a closed position, sit comfortably in the recliner, ensuring you are sitting as far back as possible.
- 2. Press the front button to lift the footrest.



- 3. The footrest will rise. Release button when comfortable or continue pressing until fully extended.
- 4. Press the back button to return the footrest to a closed position. Ensure the footrest is fully closed before standing.



#### **Customer Care**

#### **Wood Furniture**

Wood displays different grain patterns depending on which way it is cut. These are characteristics of the natural beauty of the wood. All timber surfaces will change colour and mellow over time.

#### **Fabric Care**

Every effort is made to keep colours consistent between batches, but fabric manufacturers cannot guarantee exact matching. All fabrics will fade in sunlight, to prolong the life of the fabric do not place it close to a heat source or in direct sunlight. Plump up cushions after use, especially fibre or feather cushions. If the cushions are reversible turn them at least once a week to minimise wear and maintain their appearance. To prevent dust and dirt accelerating wear, gently vacuum upholstery once a week or use a soft brush. For complete cleaning we recommend a specialist cleaning in situ. Accidental spills and stains should be treated as soon as possible, except mud which should be left to dry and then brushed off. Remove any solids, then blot up as much liquid as possible with white paper towel or a clean cloth. We recommend professional dry cleaning but some action can limit damage.
