### VIEWS OF FACTORY




## BEAUTIFUL FURNITURE


No. 273. Oak Hall Cupboard 3 ft. wide. Consists of a large carcase opened by two doors; on the reverse side of one door a mirror is fitted. The carcase contains a hat shelf with hat and coat hooks under.



No. 516. Carved oak Arm-chair. Seat covered cowhide; the arms are elegantly shaped.



No. 516. Carved oak Chair. Seat covered in cowhide.




No. 235. Oak Hall Cupboard with carved canted corners, 2 ft. 6 in. wide. The carcase has a hat shelf at the top with hat and coat hooks under, and also a rug box at bottom. A mirror is fitted on the reverse side of the door.



No. 227. Oak Writing Table or Hall Table, reproduced from the antique. A useful piece of furniture, fitted with one long drawer. Size of top:  $3 \text{ ft.} \times r \text{ ft.} 9 \text{ in.}$ 



No. 438. Oak carved Bureau, 2 ft. 6 in. wide. The interior of the desk is divided into partitions for stationery, and also one drawer; fitted with automatic pull-out slides.



No. 306. Oak Dwarf Bookcase, 3 ft. wide, fitted with three adjustable shelves. Case is enclosed by glazed doors, a very heavily built piece of furniture.




No. 788. An oak Chair of modern design modelled from the antique. The back has a "squat" appearance, and noteworthy is the embodiment of the Queen Anne shaped splat housed into the top rail. It is enriched by vine pattern carving. Fitted with a loose feather-filled cushion covered in a silk finished velvet.

No. 530. Oak Sideboard 4 ft. wide. The carcase has two large cupboards and two drawers which are hand [dove-tailed. The carcase is specially designed to give roomy accommodation in a small space.











No. 426. Oak Arm-chair with stuffed seat and back, covered in cowhide.





No. 782. A very charming small sized tub-shaped Suite enriched by carving and embossing. The whole of the suite is covered in guaranteed cowhide, it is stuffed fibre and hair, fitted with loose seat cushions, stuffed feathers, interlined downproof, covered velveteen. Size of easy chair over the arms, 26½ in.; overall back to front, 28 in.; size of settee over the arms, 4 ft. 1½ in.; overall back to front, 30 in. The show-wood of the suite is of prime quality timber finished oak or walnut colour.

No. 730. Three-piece Suite, covered in guaranteed cowhide, crushed into an antique effect, stuffed fibre and hair, cushions covered velveteen, filled feathers, interlined downproof. Carved oak show-wood. Settee, 4 ft. 3 in. Easy, 2 ft. 4 in. Height of Backs, 2 ft. 4 in.; Depth of three pieces at the arms, 26 in. The backs and seat borders may be decorated with embossings at no extra cost in this particular case.



No. 603. Oak Table extending to 5 ft.  $\times$  2 ft. 9 in., Figured Oak Top, heavily built bulbous legs and with an elegant underframe.



No. 582. Solid Oak Table with Figured Oak Top, extending to 4 ft. 6 in.  $\times$  2 ft. 6 in., with shaped and chamfered diagonal underframe.



No. 472. ADJUSTABLE CHAIR WHICH HAS BEEN TRULY DESCRIBED AS "THE BEST OF ITS KIND." The imposing and beautiful qualities of this chair are evident at a glance. It is 28 in. wide and 38 in. deep, heavily constructed of solid oak, beautifully finished in an antique effect.

The front legs are  $3 \text{ in.} \times 3 \text{ in.}$  and all other rails of proportionate weight. The joints are mortised, tenoned and cross pinned, and therefore, because of the weight of the timbers and the construction, the frame is almost indestructible.


Comfort luxurious is derived by the generous proportions of the frame as a basis, and by sheer lavish use of materials. The large soft cushions which fit the frame are actually 8 in. thick! Filled with first quality Pure Java Kapoc, are extremely soft, and in spite of their size, "they are as light as a feather." The covering is Corduroy in fawn or brown shades. It is a truly wonderful production. DURING THE LAST THREE YEARS 30,000 OF THESE CHAIRS HAVE BEEN SOLD, AND THE DEMAND IS INCREASING WEEKLY.




## HUGE SOFT DOWNY CUSHIONS




No. 515. A new production: A Bed-chair, with back adjustable to three positions, as shown on diagram 1, and by new means a fourth position enables the chair to be formed into a luxuriously comfortable day bed, as shown on diagram 2. It is also convertible into a bed (diagram 3) with a sprung mattress composed of the three cushions closely attached to each other, each cushion being filled with 25 coppered steel springs—altogether a mattress with 75 springs. As a chair it is an imposing piece of furniture with a double sprung seat and a sprung back, ensuring extreme comfort and constructed to be almost indestructible. Covered Corduroy, Brown or Grey, or in a striped Damask.



As an Easy Chair: with a double sprung seat, and a sprung back.



As a Day Bed or Lounge: the outer section of the back of the chair supports a very low angle of the back, and one of the hinged cushions as a foot rest.



As a Bed: with a sprung mattress of 75 spiral springs.
